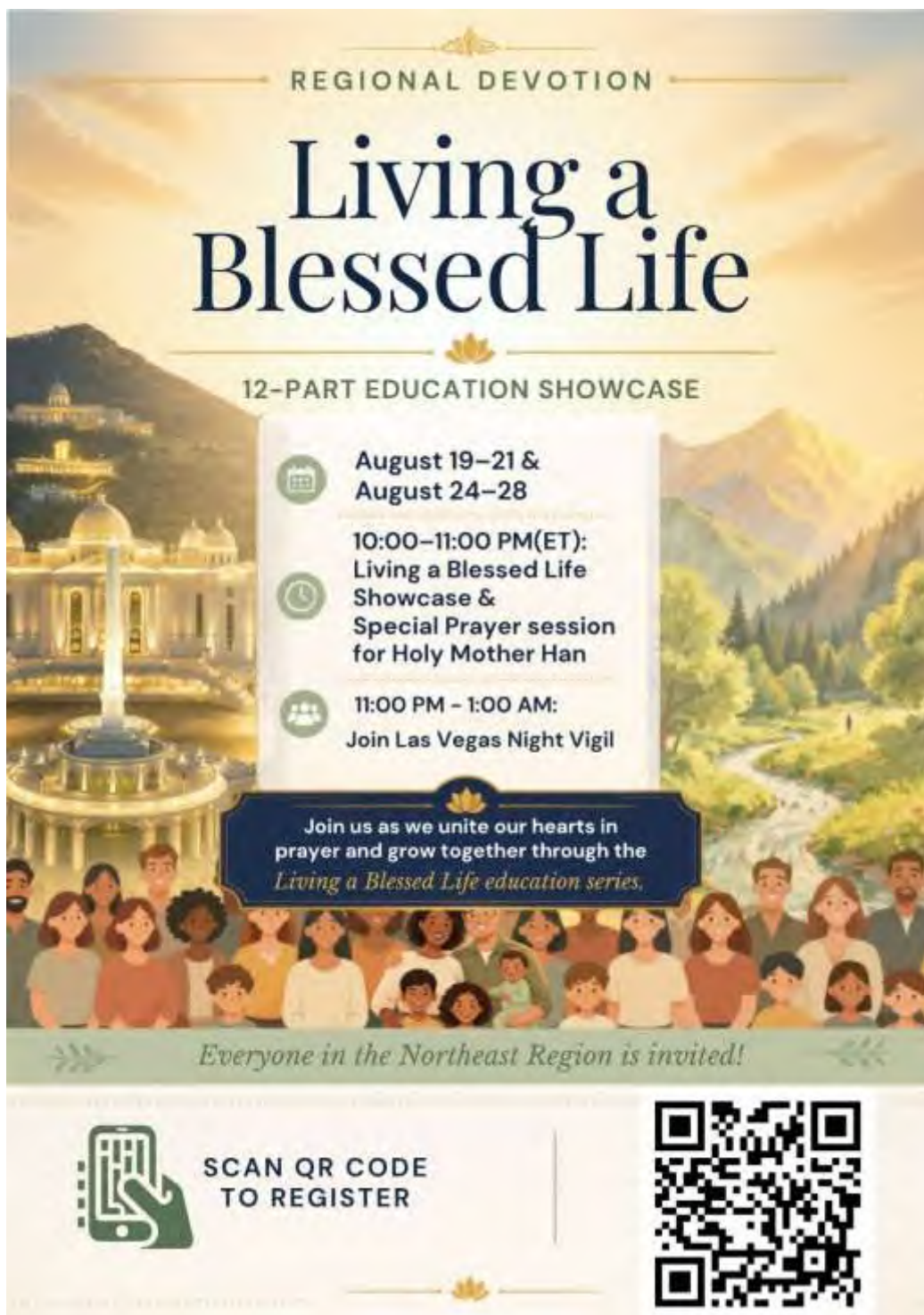

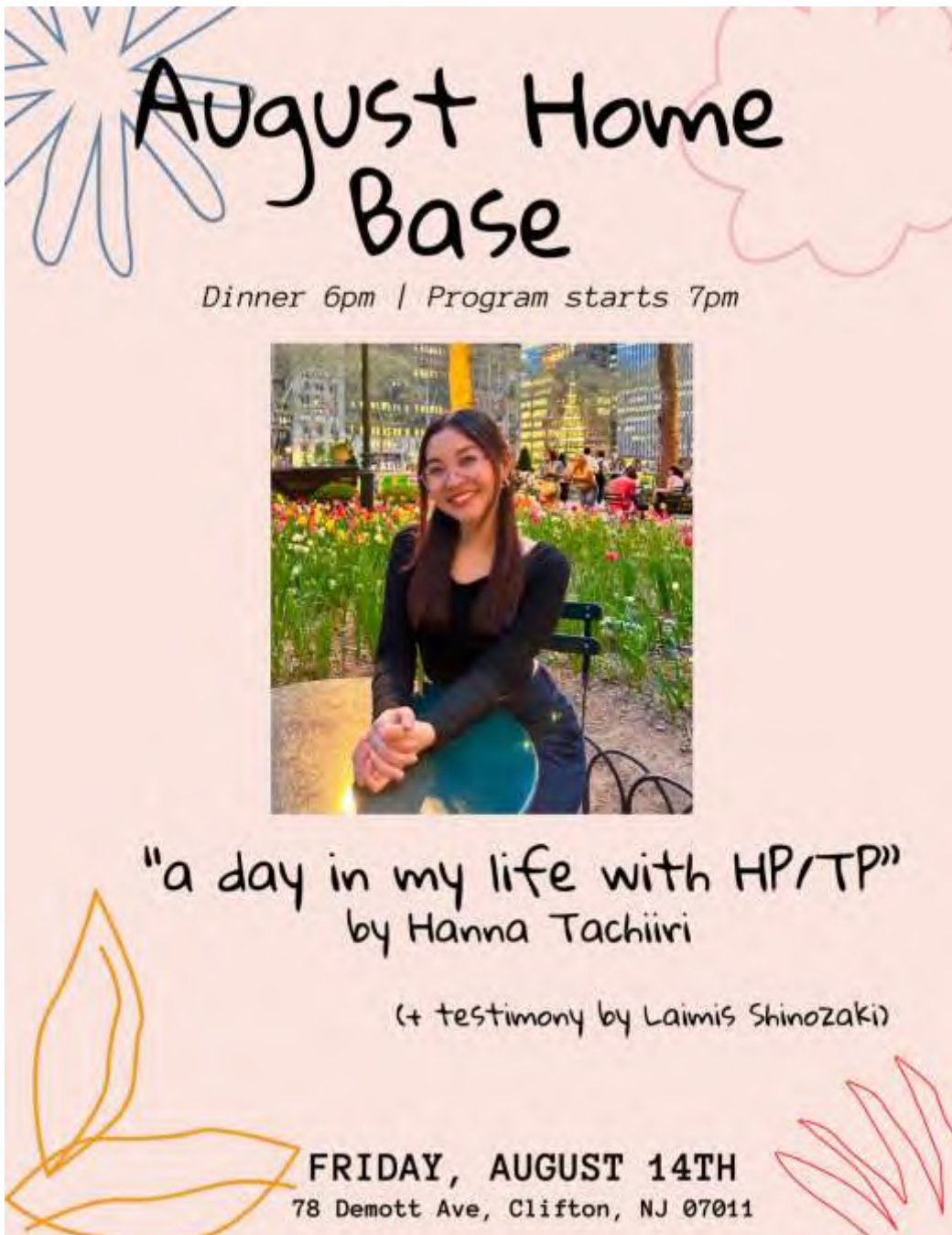

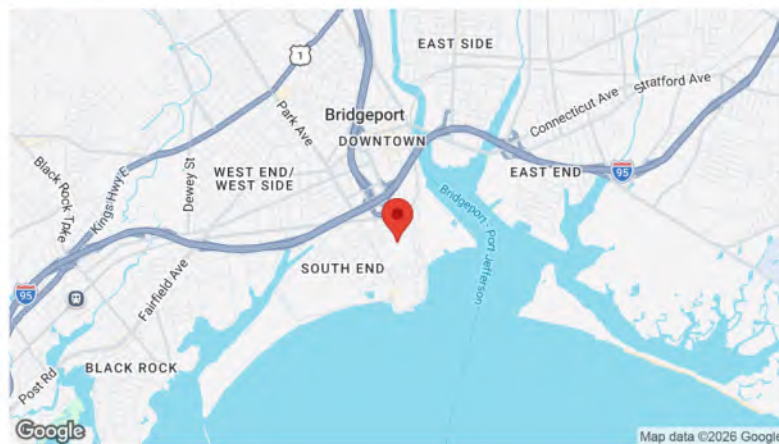
If elected to the Church Council, it is expected that you would sign and uphold the following Council Oath:

A church is more than a building it is a home. It is where faith grows, families find belonging, friendships are formed,

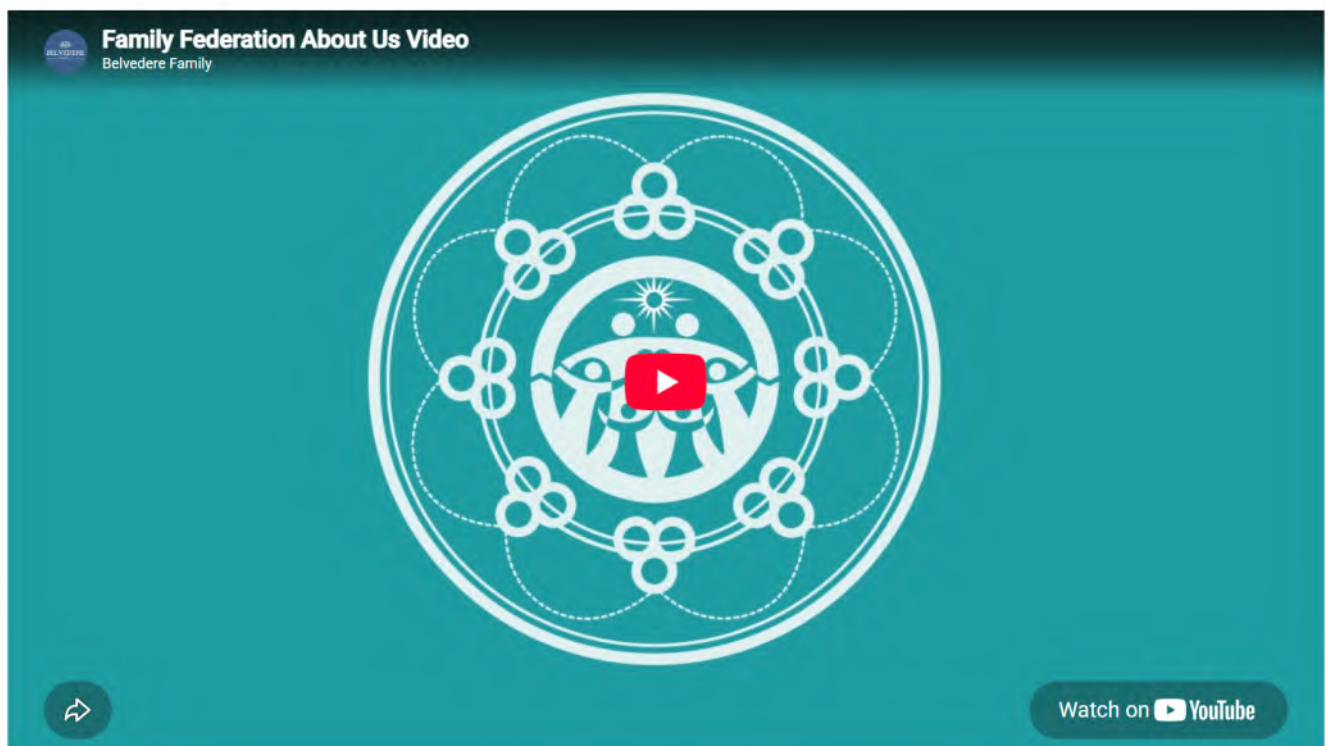
and lives are transformed.

encourages inter-religious, intercultural, and inter-racial harmony and unity centered on the family.

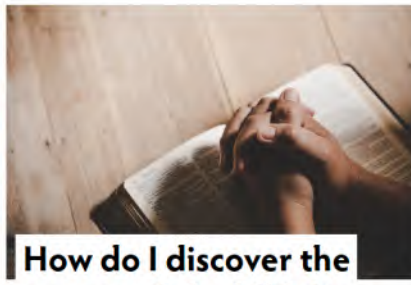

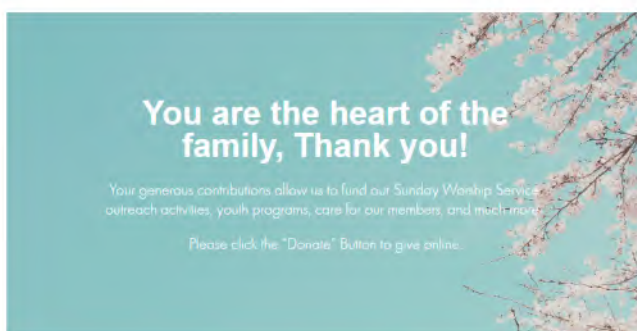

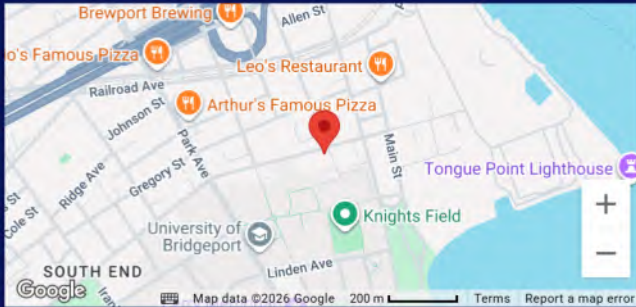
